Description of the Role:

The Youth Night Program provides educational, social and service-oriented programming, two evenings per week, year-round. Youth Nights, offered for all low-income Camden County youth ages 12-19, include a wide array of programs such as speakers, workshops, team building, leadership development and more! All topics are chosen by the youth participants themselves based on their interests and needs.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Tutoring, assisting with homework assignments (9th-12th grade)
- Working with youth to manage school homework/upcoming assignments
- Support afterschool staff in managing large groups of students

Skills/Qualifications:

- Staff will train, advise and provide guidance with youth engagement
- Experience with youth a plus but not required
- Passion for education and desire to encourage Camden students
