Description of the Role:

The Youth Night Program provides educational, social and service-oriented programming, two evenings per week, year-round. Youth Nights, offered for all low-income Camden County youth ages 12-19, include a wide array of programs such as speakers, workshops, team building, leadership development and more! All topics are chosen by the youth participants themselves based on their interests and needs.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Assist staff in pick up/ drop off of local youth for LUCY programming
- Operate vans in a professional manner when transporting youth
- Support staff in various overnight/weekend trips when needed
- Complete community delivery of prepared meals by Cathedral Kitchen staff to Camden residents

Skills/Qualifications:

- Staff will train, and provide shadow opportunities on how to operate LUCY vans
- License and auto insurance is required
- Experience with youth a plus but not required
